



- Trusted application (server-side access to the information store)



The Cross-Platform Java Client:

Java-based client

- Highly portable, highly supportable code-base
- Runs on Mac OS, Linux, Solaris, and Win32 desktops.
- Supports the GroupWise 6 and GroupWise 6.5 architecture
- Uses XML for data communications with the server

80/20 Solution suitable as a 'habitat' for most end-users

- Looks and feels like the Win32 client
- Can perform any function WebAccess can perform
- 1st-generation Offline mode (store format differs from GW archive/remote)

- Scheduled to ship as part of the Sequoia release



Basic Instant Messaging Functionality


- Presence detection Online, Idle, Away
