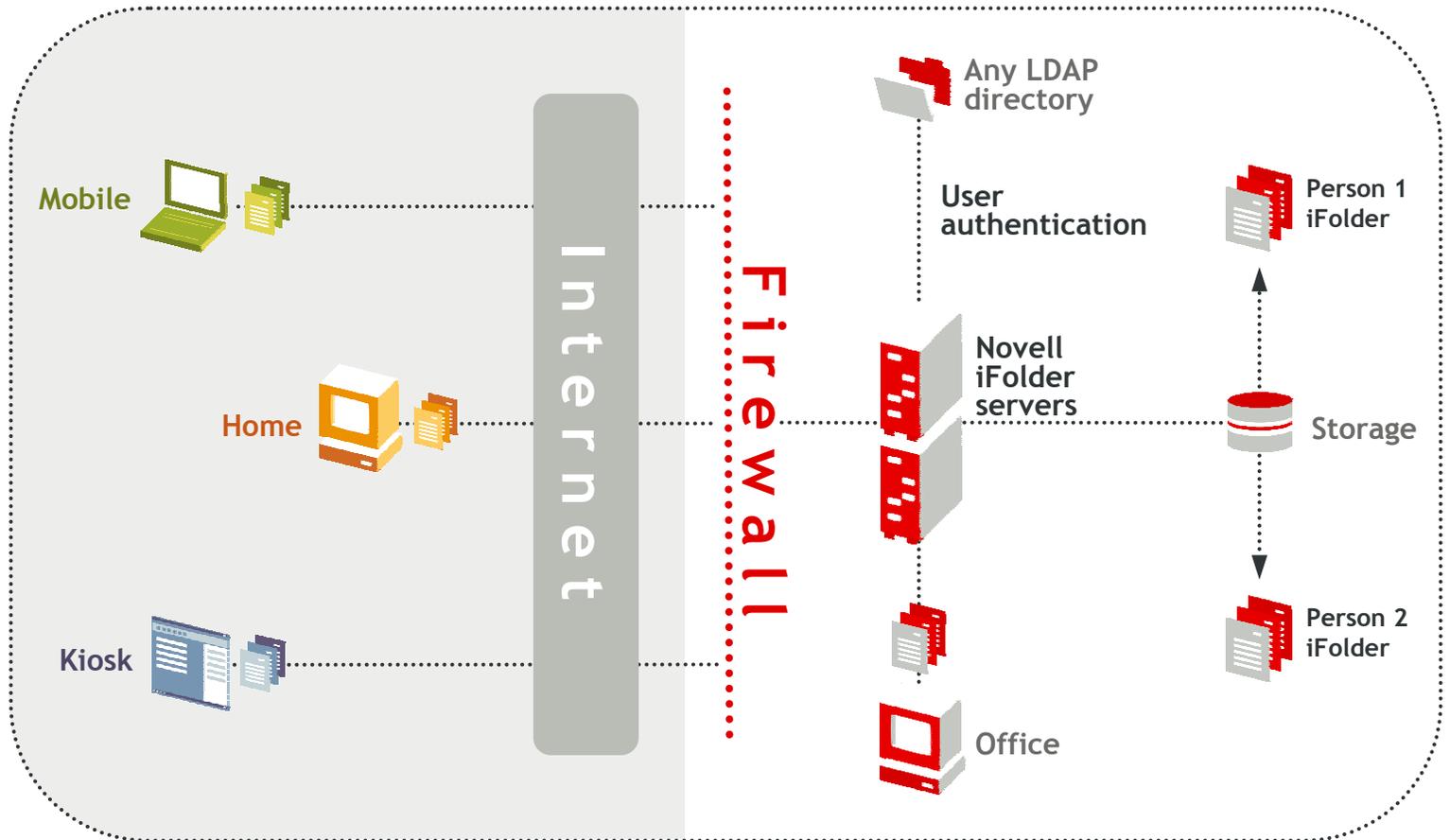
Novell iFolder lets your files follow you—everywhere

Automatically secures and protects your files

Your files are automatically backed up on the network and multiple workstations, protecting your organization's critical data

Files are encrypted during delivery and can be encrypted on the server so no one but you can access them





Novell iFolder benefits

It simplifies the way you use your files

Your files follow you everywhere

- Your files are automatically updated across the machines you regularly use (work, laptop, home)
- Your files are in a local directory, so you use them the same way you always have
- If you are on the road, you can access your files anywhere using a web browser

No need to remember complex login procedures

- Lengthy VPN logins are not required

How is it used?

Telecommuting

Solution to enable users to work from home

- applies also to people who need to do work from home at night

- **Case Study** - State of Arizona Department of Administration (ADOA)

- Profile: Provides business services to over 100 other state agencies, boards and commissions

- **Problem:**

- Studies have shown that offering a flexible workplace, such as Telecommuting, improves employee satisfaction
- However, they don't have a solution to access files from home

- **Solution:**

- With Novell iFolder, users now have high-speed, secure access to files from home via any Internet connection

How is it used?

Mobile file access

Solution to allow users to access their files from anywhere

- Case Study - Sales Rep
 - Problem:
 - Sales Rep needed to update a spreadsheet for his District Director that day or he wouldn't get paid his commission for the quarter
 - Spreadsheet was on his laptop that he had left at home
 - Solution:
 - Novell iFolder saved the day, he went to a Circuit City, "tried out" a PC that had an Internet connection.
 - Was able to download the file from the Novell iFolder Web Access, made the changes, and then emailed to his manager

How is it used?

Other ways Novell iFolder can be used:

- Synchronize data between multiple machines
- Assist users with new PCs - Novell iFolder syncs the data down to the PC automatically
- Keep bookmarks synced between PCs





How does it work?

1. Just install the small Novell iFolder client on any machine you use
 - This sets up a Novell iFolder directory on your local drive
2. Save or update any files to this local directory
 - Files are automatically delivered to the Novell iFolder server and then pushed to your other machines
3. You can also get access to your files from any Internet browser
 - Just visit your company's Novell iFolder web site, enter your ID, password, and pass phrase, and you have access to all your files (The pass phrase enables the encryption of your files)

Novell iFolder is the only Internet-ready solution

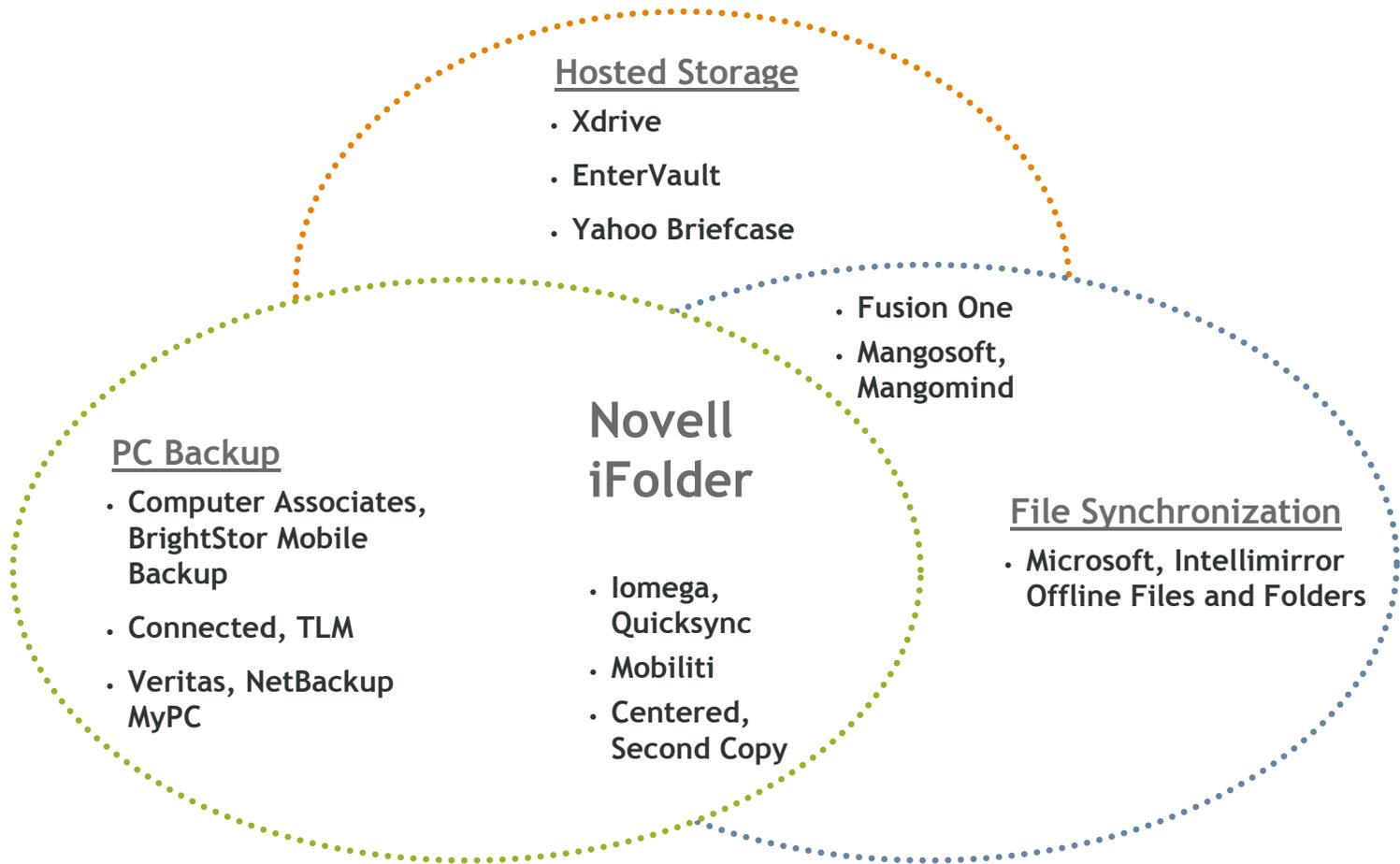


Microsoft Intellimirror offline files and folders

- Uses the CIFS LAN-based protocol and requires a VPN to access files
- Has an inefficient synchronization process (can't track or update simple changes; must update the entire file)
