- HP e3000 A/N-Class PA-8700 server sales ended as planned on October 31, 2003
- PA-8700 processor upgrades & add-on processors are available for purchase until October 31, 2004 (place your orders now!)
- Select memory, embedded disks, I/O & network cards, & external storage for HP e3000 A/N-Class servers that are shared with the HP 9000 family continue to be available in 2005* while supplies last
- Select add-on software products will continue to be available through June, 2005
- Series 9xx user license upgrades and HP e3000 to HP 9000
 A/N-Class conversion kits will be available through 2006

Supporting and evolving your existing environment



- Currently supported HP e3000 servers and releases (6.5, 7.0, and 7.5) will be supported through December 2006.
 - MPE/iX 6.5 support extended from December 2004 to December 2006



- Power Patch or Express releases continue new
 - MPE/iX 7.5 PowerPatch 2 available August, 2004
 - Future PowerPatches as needed (we estimate ~2/year)
 - Probably 7.0 PowerPatch is Next: 1H'05 (subject to change)
 - primarily for patch consolidation










What should/will HP do after HP sales and support of the e3000 end?

 - Installation services after 2003 for remarketed add-on hardware products (T&M basis)
 - Extend 9xx user license upgrades through 2006
 - MPE license transfers continue to be available


