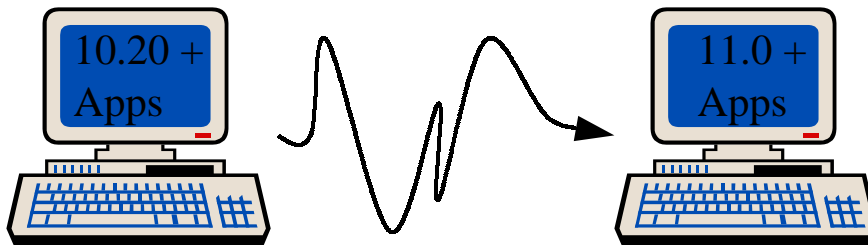

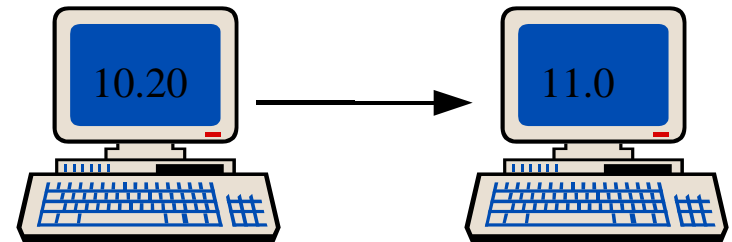
Today's Installation Experience

- Analysis after installation of layered application products shows “nuisance” errors - messages that, after investigation, can be ignored
- Update of HP-UX from one release to a newer one can require the removal of application products
- Your favorite application products may not be available at first release of the newest version of HP-UX

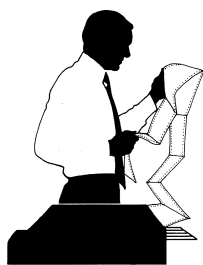
Today's Experience



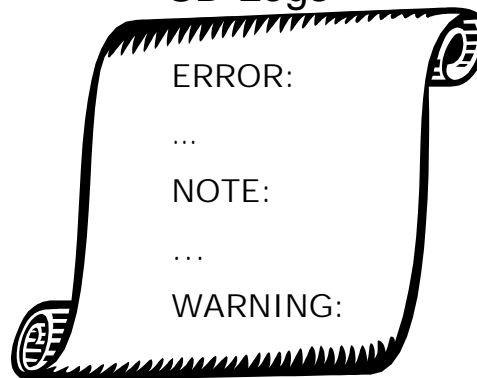
Update from one revision of HP-UX to another revision, including HP-UX layered applications, can be difficult



Historically, HP has focused on core OS Update, not including HP-UX layered applications

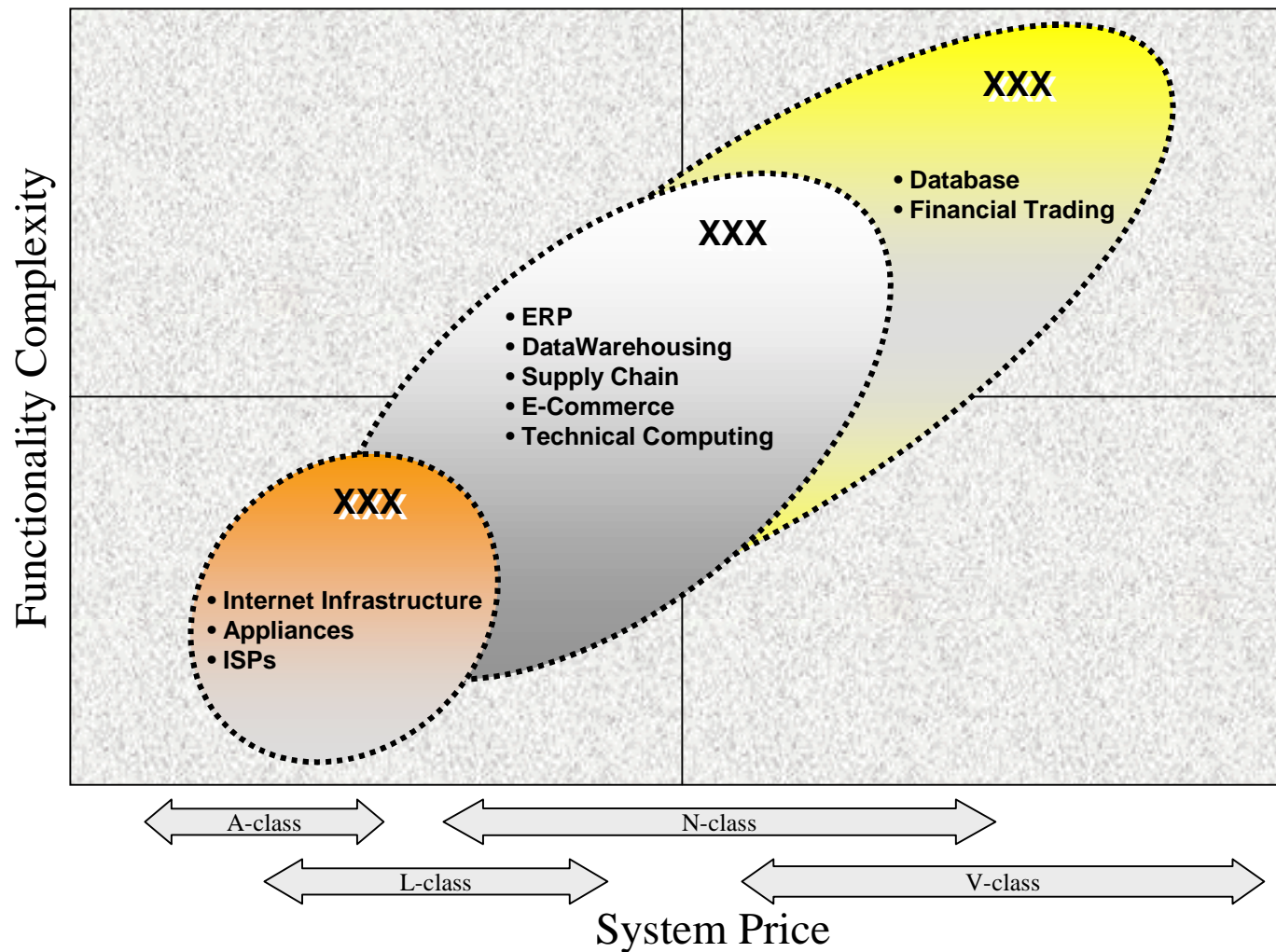




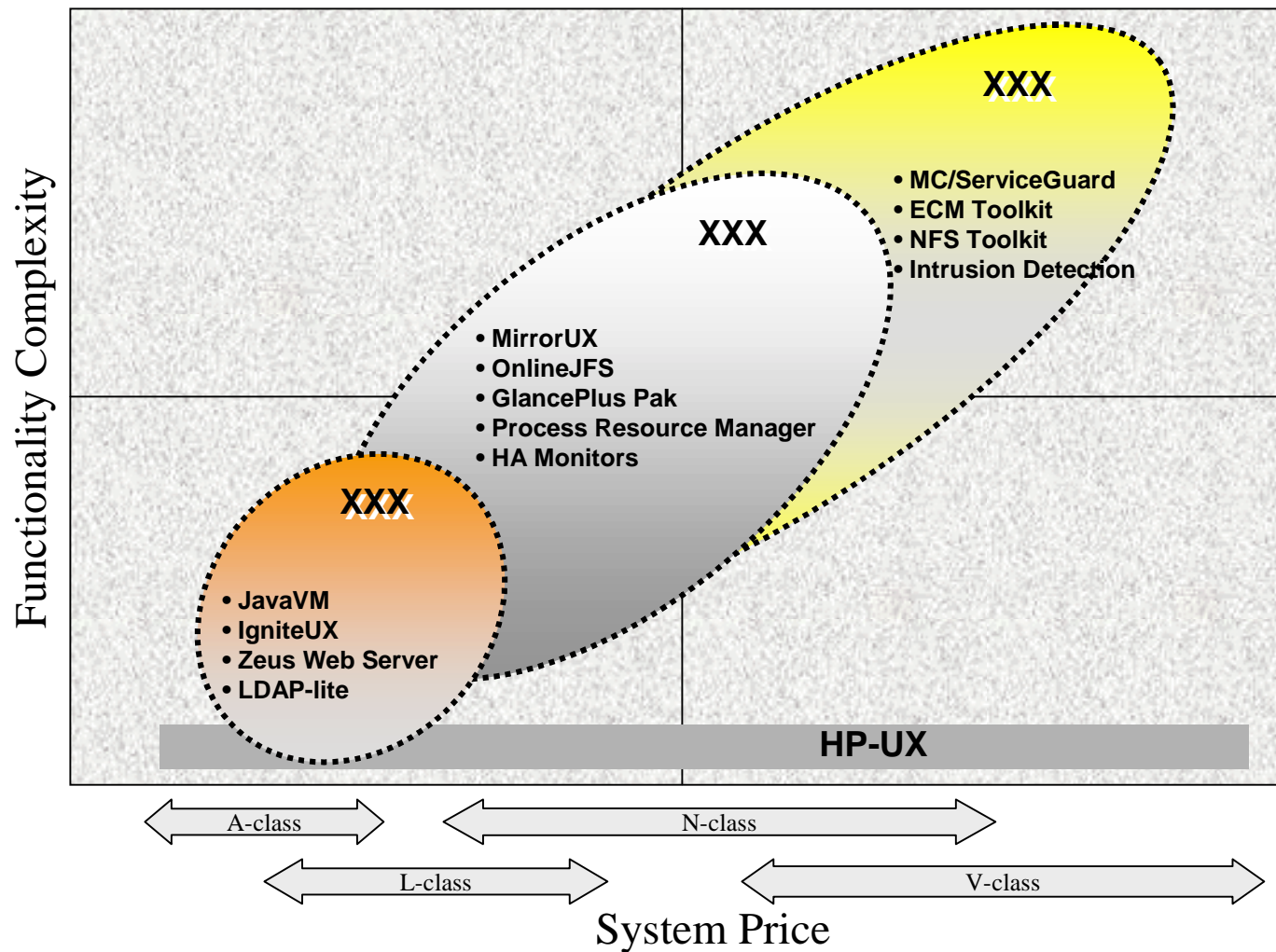
HP's Plans for Improvement

- Test using Design Centers
 - Customer usage models consisting of logical groupings of applications
- Increase test focus on Install, Remove and Update of HP-UX layered applications
- Ship key applications simultaneous with OS release
